


SACRED MEASUREMENT






GOD THE GEOMETER, THE RULER; TO MEASURE IS TO RULE!


STONE TEMPLES

The ancients were very specific in selecting the stones they used for their ceremonial sites, temples and circles. In the case of the Great Pyramid travelling up to 900kms to quarry the desired materials, that's the equivalent of travelling from Banff to Edmonton and back! When selecting stones, consider the energy you want to work with, be it masculine, feminine or dual (balanced).

Masculine rocks hold a + positive charge while feminine rocks hold a - negative charge. You may choose to substitute stone for crystal, especially within the home. Quartz is a wonderful crystal to use because it can be programmed to swing either way.





SO WHY THE FOUR DIRECTIONS?

The symbol for the four direction holds all of creation with-in it including the five mathematical constants of π , i , e , 1 & 0

Euler's number
 $e = 2.71828$



Imaginary number -1, 0, 1
 $i = \text{quadratic equation}$



The mean orbits of Jupiter & Saturn, circle the square as they transit around the Sun representing the relationship between time space and physical matter. Jupiter is known as a teacher planet representing growth and expansion, and Saturn (Jupiter's father) is known as the fatherly planet representing restriction and limitation. In English Gematria (based on a septa system), both their names are equal to the number eight, "8" being the symbol for the flow of equal or balanced energy & infinity!




Euler's Number

Discovered by Swiss mathematician Jacob Bernoulli (1618) while studying compound interest, where "e" arises as the limit of $(1 + 1/n)^n$ as "n" approaches infinity. "e" can also be calculated as the sum of the infinite series.



The Megalithic Yard

Engineer and researcher Alexander Thom discovered that many of the sacred sites across the globe followed a common unit of measure appearing in whole numbers or fractions thereof based on the unit of 2.72 feet.



The Tetrahedron and The Sphere

When you take a tetrahedron and insert it into a sphere so that each four corner points touch the surface of the sphere, the ratio of the surface area of the two solids is 2.72.



Frozen Space in Time

When water freezes, the molecules form a hexagonal lattice and the space between the molecules measures, 2.72 angstroms.

The Sun and The Moon

Now take the solar year of 365.242 and subtract the Lunar Year of 354.367, then divide it by a full lunar month of 29.53 and the result? You again, get the number 2.7154, rounded to 2.72!



Ceremonial Secrets

One of the oldest Pagan traditions gives a cord length of $65 \frac{5}{26}$ inches for a ceremonial robe, which is extremely close to two megalithic yards of 2.72 feet. Really? A cord to measure the temple? Perhaps!

APPLICATION

Your **first** quest is to create a measuring rod with the proportions or measurements of 2.72 feet, also known as 32.64 inches. You can cut your rod of power to be 16.32 inches or 8.26 inches long from end to end (65.28 inches for a stave). Once you have your stick, give it some love and make it your own! Dare I say magical wand?



**remember to leave tobacco on the ground as an offering for your wand or stave, and once you're done making it your own bless it with a smudge!*

The **second** quest is to find a cloth made of natural materials (cotton, linen, silk, wool), which will eventually become an altar cloth for you. With your measuring rod, mark out a circle (in the proportions of 2.72) on the fabric. You can do this with light pencil marks, hand-stitched thread, or fabric ink or paint. Eventually, you can get super elaborate with your creation and cross-stitch, quilt or bead it. Keep in mind to choose the size of your cloth to suit your needs best. For some of you, you'll be building a full permanent altar in your home, and for others, a portable altar will be more practical. **In an emergency, you can make an altar in a flash with your measuring rod and some stones, or draw the proportions on a piece of paper!*

And, your **third** quest is to seek out five candles or tea lights for your altar. You may choose to colour coordinate them to the four directions; Yellow, Red, Blue, White and Green or choose all one colour. The best option is beeswax, as beeswax releases negative ions in the air, but it isn't a requirement.
